FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

The **Exhibitor Resource Center** contains valuable information about Web 2.0 Expo New York 2009. Please review it thoroughly for guidelines on discounts, show rules & regulations, union jurisdictions and show management contacts to help you have a successful show.

Q. What are the show hours?

A. Wednesday, November 18, 2009 11:00am - 5:30pm (*Booth Crawl 4:00pm – 5:30pm*)
 Thursday, November 19, 2009 11:00am - 5:00pm

The Web 2.0 Expo New York 2009 exhibition will be held in the 3B Exhibit Hall of the Javits Center.

Q. Are there still marketing and sponsorship opportunities available at Web 2.0 Expo New York 2009?

Q. Who is the show contractor?

A. The general contractor is Champion Exposition Services.

Q. Where do I ship my materials and freight?

A. You have the option of shipping materials to either the advance warehouse or directly to show site. Materials sent to the advance warehouse must arrive by Monday, November 9, 2009. If shipping directly to show site, keep in mind that the venue will not accept Web 2.0 Expo New York materials until Monday, November 16, 2009. Shipping addresses are as follows:

Q. What is my set-up time?

A. Exhibitor move-in begins on Monday, November 16, 2009. Here are the dates and times for exhibitor move-in:

Monday, November 16, 2009 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. - 20x20 booths & up
Tuesday, November 17, 2009 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. - all other booths

Q. Can I request early move-in?

A. Early move-in requests will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Call Champion at 800-723-1123 to request an early move-in time.

Q. Can I set up my own booth?

A. Yes, Exhibitors may unpack, pack and arrange their merchandise and products in their exhibit. Exhibitors may install or dismantle their exhibit and lay carpet in their exhibit as long as the booth size is 100 square feet or less and the work can be done without tools. Those performing the work must be employees of the exhibiting company and must carry identification to verify that fact.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS, continued

Q. What are the height restrictions?

A. The ceiling height in the 3B Hall is 33'. Linear booths cannot exceed 8' in the high zone and 4' in the low zone. In an Island booth, the maximum height of the display is 16' and 24' for a hanging sign. Exhibitors with booth properties that extend beyond the height restriction must submit a diagram to Show Management along with a written request for a variance. Show rules supersede all other guidelines outlined in the exhibitor service manual that is posted online.

Q. Can I carry my own equipment to my booth?

A. Yes, an exhibitor may move material that can be carried by hand by one person in one trip, without the use of dollies, hand trucks or other mechanical equipment.

Q. How do I order labor to install/dismantle my booth and other booth services such as furnishings, electrical, telecom and lead retrieval?

A. Order forms are located in the Exhibitor Resource Center.

Q. Are there early bird discount deadlines for ordering items for my booth?

A. Yes. The discount deadlines vary depending on the vendor and are specified on the individual vendor forms that can be found on the exhibitor's resource center. Payment must be received to qualify for these discounted rates.

Q. How do I get a lead retrieval device?

A. You can order a lead retrieval machine by filling out the order form on the Exhibitor Resource Center.

Q. Can I use my booth during non-exhibit hours?

A. Web 2.0 Expo NY exhibitors who wish to have meetings in the exhibit hall during non-exhibit hours will be allowed to do so provided that show management is notified in advance. Exhibitors must fill out the Exhibit Hall Access form on the Exhibitor Resource Center and submit it to show management to guarantee your guests easy access to the exhibit floor. Remember: all guests must have a Web 2.0 Expo NY badge in order to gain admittance to the show floor. Meetings must be confined the exhibiting company's booth space.

Q. Are there complimentary registrations?

A. Yes. Exhibitors and sponsors receive complimentary exhibit staff badges for those working their booth. Instructions to register for these badges are in the ERC. Based on your level of participation, all sponsors are entitled to at least one complimentary full conference registration.

Q. When can I start moving out?

A. The exhibitor move-out dates and times are:

Thursday, November 19, 2009	5:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.
Friday, November 20, 2009	8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Note: All carriers (trucking companies) must check in no later than **8:00 a.m. on Friday, November 20, 2009** for freight pickup. Drivers not checked in by this time will risk the possibility of their shipments going out on the house carrier.

Q. Can I break down my booth before the show closes?

A. No. Early booth breakdown is not permitted.
